The CPM (Center for Proteomics and Metabolomics) is one of the Technology Focus Areas within the LUMC. On Thursday, May 11, from 17:00 to 19:30 we will have our second CPM research evening, presenting the research focus of the CPM, with particular attention to its collaborations within the LUMC.
